President of the Republic of Ecuador



President Guillermo Lasso Mendoza was elected President of the Republic of Ecuador in May 2021. Mr. Lasso holds over 50 years of experience in the public and private sectors in Ecuador. In 2012, he established the political party Creando Oportunidades (CREO). It was with this party that he was elected President in 2021, following his third presidential campaign.

Prior to his presidential career, Mr. Lasso was the Executive President of Banco Guayaquil (1994–

2012), and established Ecuador Libre, a think-tank and not-for-profit organization whose objective is the investigation, analysis, and diffusion of public policies based on liberal principles. He also held political roles at regional and national levels in Ecuador.

In 2011, he received an Honorary Doctorate from the Universidad de las Americas (Americas University), in Quito. He has also authored two books: *Cartas a mis hijos* (Letters to my children) y *Otro Ecuador es posible* (Another Ecuador is possible).

On Tuesday 2nd November, Canning House will host a Canning Lecture with His Excellency Guillermo Lasso Mendoza, President of the Republic of Ecuador, in Glasgow.

The President, whose Canning Lecture in Glasgow coincides with his visit to the United Kingdom for the United Nations Climate Change Conference (COP26), will speak on the topic: 'More Ecuador in the World and More of the World in Ecuador.'

Lord Mountevans, Honorary President of Canning House, will inaugurate the event and welcome attendees. After the President has delivered his lecture, there will be an opportunity for audience questions, moderated by Cristina Cortes, Canning House CEO. Nick McCall, Chair of Canning House, will close the Canning Lecture. The event will be followed by a networking reception.

Since 1997, the Canning Lecture has been delivered by a visiting Latin American or Iberian President or Head of Government. The Canning Lecture is one of the most high-profile such events in the UK, and a unique opportunity to hear from and engage directly with a current Latin American or Iberian leader.
