Minister for Industry and Trade of the Dominican Republic












Jeremy Browne CEO - Canning House

He returned to Britain to write for Television Business International and cover the European equity markets for the Forbes.com London bureau. Executive Director - Export and Investor




Executive Director - Export and Investment Centre of the Dominican Republic (PRODOMINICANA)
