**Ramón Fiestas Hummler**  
**President Latin America - Global Wind Energy Council (GWEC)**



Ramón is a lawyer, providing consultancy over the last 20 years in renewable energy matters and serving as Barrister at the Spanish Courts, including litigations at the EU Court of Justice. He has taken part in the settlement of the markets for wind power in Brazil, Mexico, Uruguay and Chile, and more recently in Argentina and Colombia as President of GWEC Latin America. He joined the GWEC as a founding member representing the Spanish Wind Energy Association (AEE) in its Board.



**Juan Antonio Gutierrez**  
**Technical Advisor - Peruvian Hydrogen Association**



Juan Antonio is a chemical engineer from the National Autonomous University of Mexico and is a specialist in hydrogen technologies with more than 8 years' experience in the sector. He currently works as Technical Advisor for the Peruvian Hydrogen Association and Senior Consultant for the international firm NTT DATA. Juan Antonio is a member of the Project Development Commission in the Mexican Hydrogen Society.

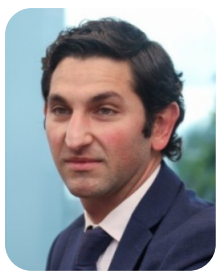


**Chris Knight**
